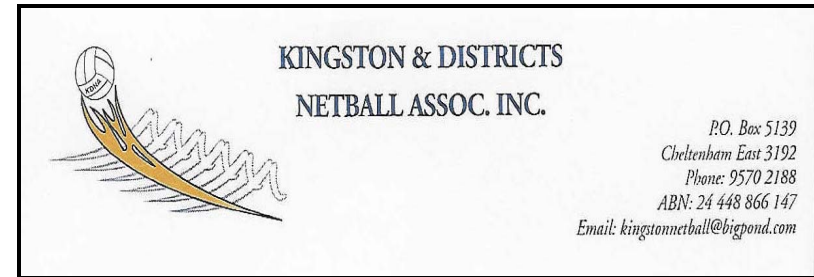

FINALS: (Continued)

Teams that require "fill-in" player/s to make the required 7 players for the match must notify the Registration Officer of:

1. Player name/s that are unavailable
2. Name of "fill-in" player/s

Fill-in Player/s must be from Club team of equal/lower age division provided that team is not involved in the finals series. Refer By-Laws Section 5 20.6 This must be done 3 days prior to the day of competition to enable Registration Officer to verify eligibility of said player/s.

UMPIRES:

KDNA will supply all umpires to all scheduled matches. They will consist of "Trainees" at the first two time-slots of the Saturday Outdoor Competition KDNA will endeavour to supply to all other time slots a "'C" badged umpire to assist the junior umpires.

Umpire Supervisors are on "duty" whenever possible to oversee and work with the junior umpires.

CAR PARKING:

Warrigal Rd has become a "NO STANDING" area between 8.00am and 5.00pm. KDNA parking for patrons is provided on the grass area adjacent to the courts. Entry to this is via Old Dandenong Rd (right hand turn and lights) – right at Columbia St – right at Washington Drive.

CANTEEN:

Open on match days and managed by an independent operator.

FIRST AID:

Ice is available from the "First Aid" area on Saturdays and from Court Supervisor on Wednesdays. We would encourage all Clubs/Teams to include a "first – aid" kit as part of the equipment that is supplied to your Coaches, so players can receive the attention they need at the court side. More serious injuries can be addressed by our "first aid" officer, who can only assess at the time and advise a suitable course of action, should they need further treatment

Kingston & Districts invites your Club/Team to compete in the 2012 Autumn Competition

The following include major rules for 2012 Autumn Competition organised by KDNA Committee of Management. When you enter the Competition you accept to play by all Rules of the Association.

Amended By Law 13.13 September - In the interest of players and spectator safety dogs are not permitted courtside. KDNA Comm Mgr request dog owners to refrain from bringing dogs to Dales Park during competition and training sessions

Matches:

11Yrs/U – 9.00am 9.50am & 10.40am
13Yrs/U - 11.30am, 12.20pm, 1.10pm
15Yrs/U- 1.10pm, 2.00pm, 2.50pm
17Yrs/U – 2.50pm 3.40pm Open 3.40pm 4.30pm

Fees: Netta **\$ 90.00 per team incl GST**
11's, 13's, 15', 17's, Open Age **\$500.00 per team incl GST**

All Team fees must be paid to the Treasurer by Round 3, March 3rd

HOW TO ENTER:

Enclosed is team sheet/s, and a player list to enable correct completion of your team sheets

Team sheet/s are to be completed with all sections completed

Address details ONLY if changed,

PREVIOUS GRADE COLUMN

Please complete with all relevant details (example- 13B1/1 or 13B1 Saints, or if "New")

This will assist Match Committee with the correct grading for your clubs.

Coaches details along with email address will ensure that all Coaches will receive relevant information from KDNA during Autumn 2012 season

Incomplete team sheets will **NOT** be accepted.

COMPULSORY 2012 VNA REGISTRATION FOR ALL PLAYERS

KDNA will provide each Club/Team with a Netball Vic VNA list of their players- please highlight all players requiring VNA registration. For any player and/or coach not on list, a separate list (using a KDNA team entry sheet) with ALL details that are required to be submitted to Registration Officer.

Registrations are processed to NV from this list and not the team sheets

Please summarise this listing (i.e. total Modified, Junior and Senior) and forward to Registration Officer **by mail** your club/team sheets and VNA payment (cheques payable to KDNA) by:

Wednesday 1st February 2012

Every Player must hold a Netball Victoria Membership as you are entering to play with a Netball Victoria Affiliated Association – All players, coaches and umpires in Victoria are required to pay an annual membership fee.

Prices are: \$58.00 Seniors - \$40.00 Juniors – players under the age of 18 as at 31.12.2012 - \$30.00 Modified – players under the age of 12 as at 31.12.2012.

Single game vouchers for players without VNA who wish to compete in a game on any one day may be purchased from the Court Supervisor prior to their game at a cost of \$8.00 per game.

COMPETITION MATCHES:

All matches will be 4 x 10 minute quarters with a 3 minute break at the half time interval. **No break in time at ¼ and ¾ time – quick change of ends for both teams. Coaches are not to go onto the courts at these breaks- players not to leave the court – drinks can be brought to the side of the court – thank you.**

Both team balls supplied for the match to be used equally.

First named team has centre pass and the other team choice of ends

First named team to collect scoresheet.

All players participating in the match must have a playing position recorded as they take the court. Players NOT participating in the days match must be crossed off the score sheet. **All four (4) playing positions for Netta and 11Yrs/U players MUST be recorded on the score sheet each week**

Proof of age for all new players to KDNA must be shown to the Court Supervisor before that player takes the court for her 2nd game.

Players that were not listed on Club/Team submitted team sheet to KDNA must have all their details recorded on score sheet of their first match.

Players may only play 2 matches on any one day of competition, the second match being with the same Club in an equal or higher grade of the same age division or an older age division than the team in which the player is registered.

A player bleeding must leave the court. Refer to “BY Laws” for further clarification

Clubs responsibility to supply different colour patches/bibs where needed.

Extreme Weather: Refer to “By Law” Section 3 13.6

FIXTURE PICK-UP:

Compulsory Delegates meeting- Monday 9th February. 7.30 Dales Park venue.

Clubs with 3 or more teams in the competition must have at least 2 adult delegates in attendance

UNIFORMS:

Each team will have 7 players on court in the same design and colour uniform by Round 3. Trackpants, bike shorts, gloves, hard peak caps and singlet tops are **not permitted** to be worn. Soft caps may be worn.

A windcheater may be worn but must be of the Clubs t/shirt colour.

Fingernails must be kept short or securely taped with soft tape. Not white or brightly coloured tape. All jewellery must be removed, although weddings rings and or earrings may be worn if securely taped. Visible body piercing must be taped and approved by Umpires Supervisor prior to play commencing. Netball briefs must be dark or matching in skirt colour, must be worn by all female players. Boy's shorts should not have pockets, or pockets to be taped over. The umpire may direct the player to leave the court if incorrect uniform is worn.

KDNA BY LAWS:

INELIGIBLE PLAYER/S - Fine \$50 and penalty loss 4pts

VNA Registration not current, “fill-in” games exceeding the allowed 2, proof of age not provided by game 2, no clearance provided from existing club if 12 months has not elapsed .

FORFEITS - Fine \$70- loss 4pts

CLUB/TEAM - Fine \$50- loss 2pts for each team:

Non attendance for clubs's designated duty roster.

Non attendance by Club Rep/s for KDNA's Delegates meeting.

- 4pt Penalty for each team:

Any Club/team with unpaid team fees by third round of season:

FORFEITS/WALKOVERS:

The Penalty for Infringement of KDNA “By Laws”: Games with defaulting players/s shall be forfeited to opponents, such team being treated as giving a Walkover

CLEARANCES:

Players require a clearance if less than 12 months has elapsed since playing with a registered KDNA Club. If a player has not taken the court for a period more than 12 months no Clearance is required.

Netta players do not require a clearance if changing Clubs.

After the commencement of any given season a player may NOT clear to another Club if said player has participated in 3 games with their registered team. KDNA Bylaws should be referred with respect to representative players.

FINALS:

Each Team competing in any of the 3 weeks of finals are required to \$25 per team per game – Clubs will be invoiced for the final series - Single team entry, KDNA would appreciate payment each week your team participates in a finals match. Prior to the start of the finals games we request that Team Managers /Coaches fill in players starting positions – score sheets are held at the Court Supervisor's window and are brought to the game by the attending umpires All players in finals matches must have played at least 3 games with their team to qualify for finals.
